


The Science Center is inviting me to have a fun time at the museum when I won't feel so overwhelmed

Sometimes I might need to relax and that is ok! I can use a Sensory Kit to help me.






## Welcome to the Eugene Science Center! Let's read together

I can watch a show with the lights on.


I can go into the Planetarium to relax when there isn't a show.




### Here are some activities I can explore.
